1. Your privacy

At Frontier Digital Ventures Limited ("Frontier" or the "Company") we value and respect privacy. We take our obligations under the Privacy Act and other applicable laws very seriously.

This policy is intended to describe the personal information we collect, how we protect it, what we do with it and your privacy rights. This policy applies only to us, the Australian company called Frontier Digital Ventures Limited, and not to our related companies, including those companies which operate online classifieds businesses.

2. Personal information

Personal information is information about you as an identifiable individual.

The types of personal information we collect include current and historical information about your name, contact details, identification, organisation, employment, positions held, forms submitted, payment details, interests, preferences, opinions and enquiry/complaint details. We also collect personal information about your dealings with us, including from any contact we have with you by telephone, online and other electronic communications.

If you apply to or do invest in our company, we may collect information you submit to us or our share registry service provider through subscription agreements and other related documents and forms. For example, we may collect information about the number of shares you hold or seek, any power of attorney you grant, your shareholder reference number or holder identification number and your tax file number if you choose to provide it.

We collect personal information under certain laws including the Income Tax Assessment Act, the Corporations Act 2001 (Cth) and the ASX Listing Rules.

3. How personal information is collected

We collect personal information from you directly and from our share registry service provider, MUFG Pension & Market Services ("MUFG") (formerly Link Market Services). Please visit <a href="https://investorcentre.linkgroup.com/Login/

We may also collect personal information from other sources including public sources, our related companies, your organisation, your representatives (e.g. your broker), information service providers and the parties with whom we exchange information as described here.

4. Purposes for collecting personal information

We collect, hold, use and disclose personal information to operate our business and comply with our legal obligations. This includes assessing your application to invest with us, managing your investment, providing investor services, identifying you, maintaining and updating our records, protecting our lawful interests, facilitating acquisitions and potential acquisitions of our business and communicating and managing our relationships with our investors and other stakeholders.

We may not be able to do these things without your personal information. For example, we may not be able to communicate with you.

5. Disclosure of personal information

We are required to make limited shareholder details available to members of the public on request.

We may also exchange your personal information with our related bodies corporate, your and our representatives, regulatory authorities, the ASX and our service providers. Our service providers include our share registry MUFG and providers of archival, auditing, accounting, legal, business consulting, banking, payment, mailing, data processing, data analysis, document management, information broking, research, investigation, insurance, website and technology services.



Some of the third parties described above may be located outside of Australia.

6. Our website

If you visit www.frontierdv.com (the "Website") to read, browse or download information, our system may record information such as your server address, top level domain (e.g. .com, .au, etc.), date and time of your visit to the Website, pages accessed, information downloaded, previous site visited and browser type. This information is used for statistical, reporting and website administration and maintenance purposes.

Like many other websites, our Website may use 'cookies' from time to time. A cookie is a piece of information that allows our system to identify and interact more effectively with your browser. The cookie helps us to maintain the continuity of your browsing session and remember your details and preferences when you return. You can configure your web browser software to reject cookies however some parts of our Website may not have full functionality in that case. See www.allaboutcookies.org for instructions on deleting and rejecting cookies for many common browsers.

7. Storage and security of personal information

We implement a range of measures to protect the security of personal information, including – depending on the circumstances – electronic access controls, premises security and network firewalls. We hold personal information electronically and in hard copy form, both at our own premises and with the assistance of our service providers.

Please provide as much detail as you can about the particular information you seek, in order to help us locate it. We will provide our reasons if we deny any request for access to or correction of personal information. Where we decide not to make a requested correction to your personal information and you disagree, you may ask us to make a note of your requested correction with the information.
